Wherever this has been identified the Welfare Officers have tried to encourage these individuals and parents to come forward to apply for hardship funding, but as yet no applications have been submitted.

One young player was injured in a match on the new ground at Mistley C C which necessitated an A and E visit. No permanent damage was inflicted and the young person involved was soon milking sympathy for a classic black eye.
